



### Activities and Curriculum

Our curriculum is designed to expand each child's knowledge and skills in all developmental areas physical, social, emotional, and intellectual. We will help the children learn how to learn and assist in establishing foundation for life-long learning. The curriculums are integrated so that learning occurs primarily through projects, learning centers and playful activities and reflect the current interests of children. Curriculum and instruction are responsive to the individual differences in ability and interests of each child. Different levels of ability, development and learning styles are expected, accepted and encouraged. Parents will be informed of their child's development and progress through daily communication with their child's teacher and during bi-annual Parent/Teacher conferences.

### Parent Provisions

Parents are required to submit completed paperwork as required by both the Office of Child Development and Just Like Home Daycare Center prior to their child(ren)'s first day and throughout their time with Just Like Home. Parents are asked to provide the basic individual needs of their child(ren), such as: two bottles, binkies, diapers, extra weather appropriate clothing, and a nap mat

As a facility in the Keystone Stars Program, we address safety and health standards – exceeding those set forth by the Office of Child Development's Daycare division. ### Assessments

A written, planned program of daily activities based on a child's individual development is established and implemented. The object of this program shall be to foster incremental developmental progress through personal assessments and evaluations. Upon enrollment, each child receives a Child Intake and Evaluation Booklet in which observations and assessments are kept. This booklet will transition into each class with them, and will serve as a running record of their growth. As children transition, each teacher will assess the child and form new goals for the individual. Parent/Teacher conferences are offered bi-annually during the school year.
